Professors from Jade UAS will constantly assist and support you.

The Program

The carousel week runs from 09 a.m. on Monday, April 12th, 2021 until approximately 2 p.m. on Friday, April 16th. The week before (starting April 5th), there will be activities to get to know each other and try out methods of international online collaboration.

During the carousel week, you will work in small teams with fellow students from other countries and faculties to take up challenges of supply chain management for large productions like in car factories.

You will hear supporting lectures explaining the standard solving methods. You will learn about logistic process design and building reasonable internal supply chains for a production, using appropriate tools and methods. You will have to respect boundary requirements and find a cost effective way using Activity Based Costing.

Each team gets a different task with individual conditions. During the teamwork, there will be continuous support by professors and assistants to help you. In a presentation session on Friday, we will discuss and explain the results of each team.
